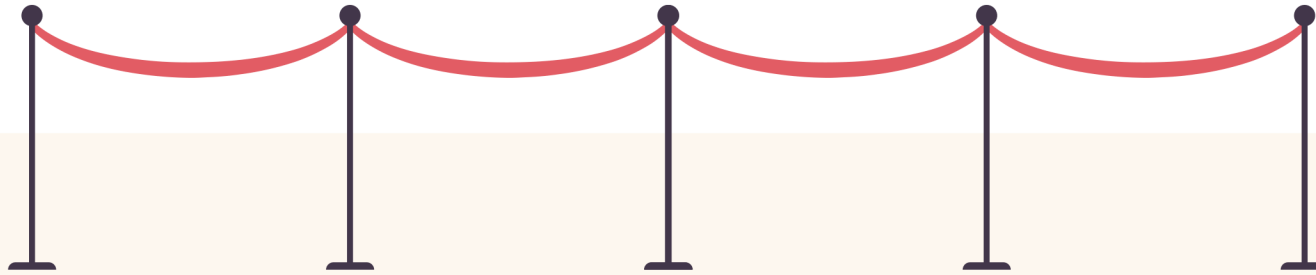

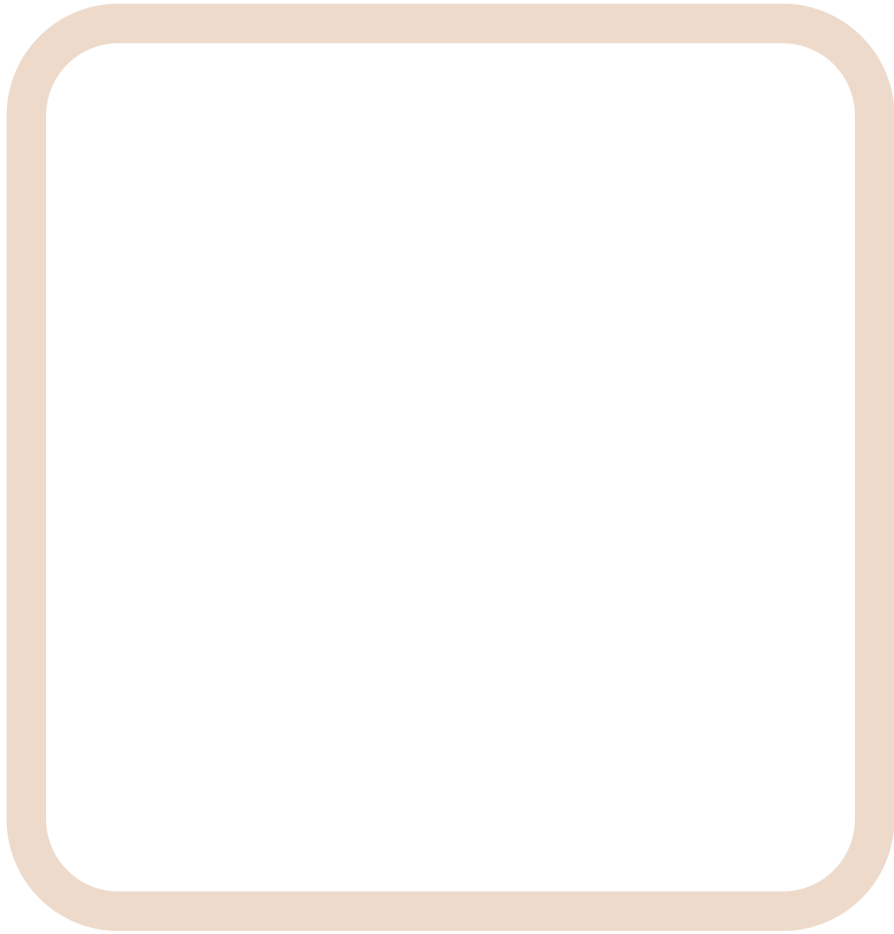


MUSEUM RULES

- Do you have any favorite artists or styles that you would like to see more of?

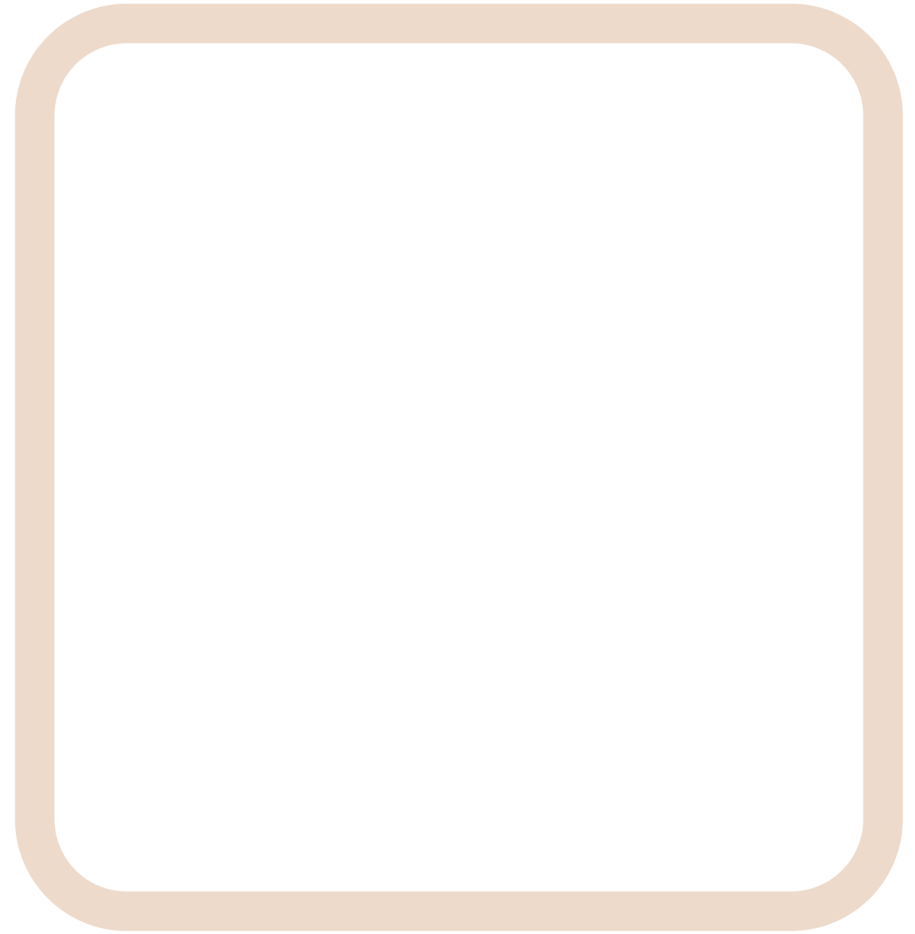

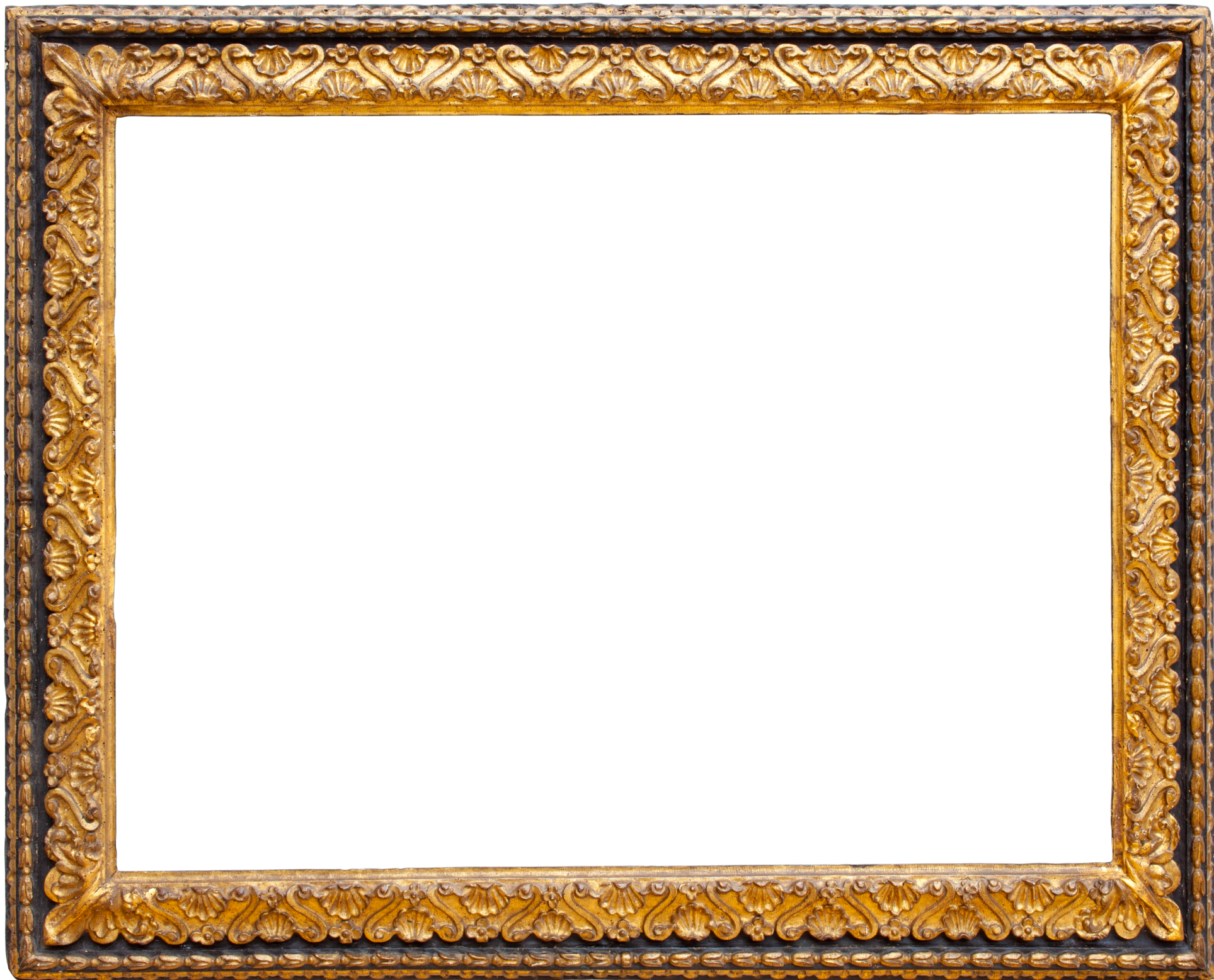

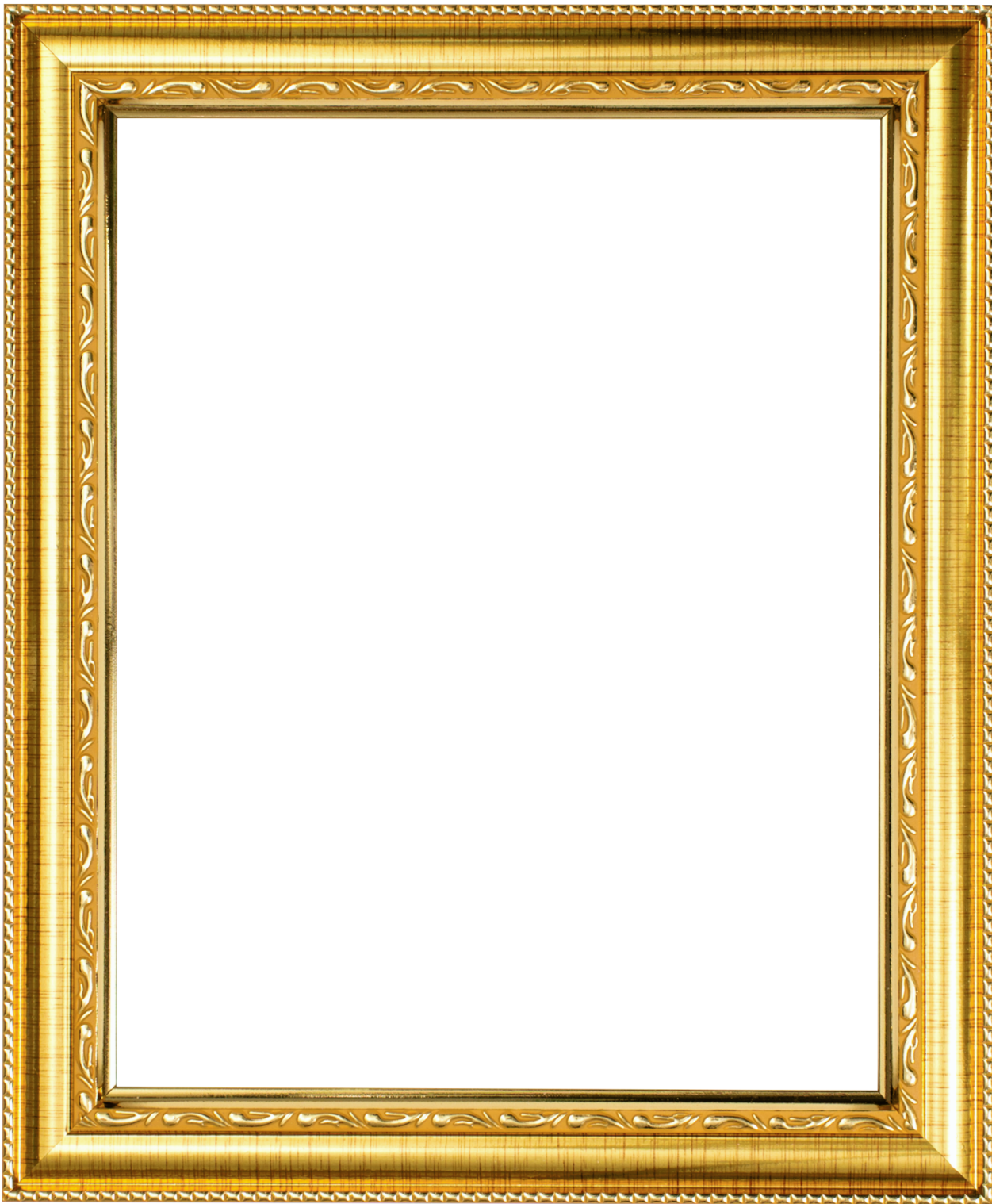
